Tiffany Stained Glass Style Hooking

Ania Knap held her Tiffany Stained Glass Workshop to introduce members to a different style of rug hooking and discussed many interesting aspects about Tiffany stained glass. She noted that most Tiffany Stained Glass was designed by women in the late 1800's to early 1900's. Ania discussed drapery glass which has three dimensional folds (like drapes); confetti glass, and favrile glass, which is iridescent.

Hooking to get a "stained glass look" is about both the material and the method. For wool,

Ania prefers to spot dye her wool to include white areas. When the wool is hooked, these white areas come across as highlights would in stained glass.

Ania's method of hooking includes directional (up and down for sky; horizontal back and forth for water), as well as cutting the wool pieces in order to achieve a "rippling" effect in the piece. Since each piece of glass would have leading around it, she uses a spot dyed dark wool to mimic her leading.

In her demonstration piece, Ania used rug warp and hooked loops size #4.
