GOOD EATS

Broccoli Slaw Salad
from the kitchen of Dot Woodle

- 2/3 cup olive oil
- 1/3 cup cider vinegar
- 2/3 cup sugar (or less)
- 2 3-oz chicken Ramen noodles (broken)
- 10-oz broccoli slaw
- 3/4 cup sliced almonds
- 3/4 cup golden raisins
- 1/2 cup sliced green onions
- 1/2 cup chopped green pepper

Whisk oil, vinegar, sugar, and noodle seasoning.
Combine broccoli, noodles, almonds, raisins, onions, and pepper. Add dressing. Refrigerate. Make salad at least 2 hours ahead.
